

Social Media Competition Terms and Conditions

Fairfield City Council is giving away eight (8) prizes to local young people aged 16-24 who take part in the 'like and tag' social media competition on the Bring It On! Youth Festival Instagram account. The prizes are four (4) Stockland Gift Cards of \$50 value each (\$200 in total) and four (4) food vouchers to be redeemed at nominated food stalls participating at the *Bring It On! Youth Festival* of \$25 value each (\$100 in total).

Promotional Period:

Thursday 16 April – Sunday 19 December 2026 at 4:15pm (3 days in total)

How to enter:

1. On the pinned reel on the Bring It On! Youth Festival (@bringitonfest) Instagram account, tag a friend through a comment and like the reel.
2. Entrants meet eligibility criteria listed below (included but not limited to being a young person aged 16-24). Due to social media age restriction legislation, this give away is not open to young people under the age of 16.
3. Entrants must attend the Bring It On! Youth Festival event on Sunday 19 April. Winners will be selected at random from eligible entrants and their social media profile name and tag will be read out at 4:15pm on the Main Stage. Winners must collect their prize in-person at the Event Information tent on the day after showing proof of profile ownership.
4. If the winner does not present themselves to the Event Information tent in one hour, a new winner will be selected at random and privately messaged through Instagram.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This competition is being coordinated by DYSS Events on behalf of Fairfield City Council (the 'Promoter'). Stockland Gift Voucher prizes have been provided via in-kind sponsorship from Stockland Wetherill Park.

By entering into this competition, you are agreeing to the following Terms and Conditions:

Standard Terms

Entry instructions and prize information form part of these conditions of entry. By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these conditions of entry.

No entries will be accepted after each closing date.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Entrants must be young people aged 16-24.
2. Employees and their immediate families of Fairfield City Council's Social Planning and Community Development Division (SPCD) and the Executive Leadership Team (ELT) are excluded from this promotion. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, sibling, step-sibling or first cousin.
3. Promotion runs for a period commencing: 16 April – 19 April 2026.
4. Limit of one (1) entry per person is permitted.
5. Entrant must have a social media account to participate and be able to be contacted by the Promoter about prize and redemption.

6. Entrant must be able to collect their prize at the Event Information Tent at the Bring It On! Youth Festival on the day of the event. Winners who cannot collect their prize after a reasonable time will forfeit said prize.
7. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
8. The Promoter's decision is final, and the Promoter will not enter into any correspondence.
9. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity and age) and to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process or who submits an invalid entry. An entry is invalid if not submitted in accordance with these conditions of entry. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
