Things to see

BLAND OAK TREE

Standing at 13m tall with a 30m wide canopy, Oakdene Park's historic Bland Oak Tree received recognition in 2018 when it was listed on the National Register of Significant Trees. Planted in 1850 by Dr William Bland, the tree is an important symbol of the City's history.
